WHAT KSDS OFFERS:

Complimentary Hebrew, Judaic, and General Studies Spring/Summer tutoring sessions:

Sessions will either be one-on-one or small group based on grade, background knowledge and schedule.



KSDS matches new families with three current families based on student age and interests so lateral entry students have many opportunities to connect with classmates.



One-day August boot camp:

Includes a crash course in navigating our hallways and routines as well as team-building activities to get comfortable with teachers and classmates.

Ongoing support:

One-on-one consultations with the Director of Bridges for students and families throughout the transition period.
