This year, we expanded and deepened our literacy program, ensuring that every student continues to build strong foundational skills while being inspired by the richness of Jewish texts, the power of reading and writing, and a lifelong love of books. This focus culminated in first-place wins for both our elementary and middle school teams in the nationally recognized Battle of the Books. Our library staff and dedicated parent volunteers guided this major achievement.

We also celebrated exciting physical improvements on campus, including the refurbishment of our school lobby and upgrades to shared spaces throughout the building. These enhancements reflect our commitment to creating an environment that is welcoming, inspiring, and functional for students, faculty, and families.

Our connection to Israel remains strong. For the fourth consecutive year, our 8th grade students performed their all-Hebrew musical, *The Lion King*, to a sold-out audience at the Beit Mazia Theater in the heart of Jerusalem during their Israel trip. Our curriculum, programs, and student initiatives continue to reflect this commitment. Our sense of responsibility as a Jewish day school has never been stronger.

Battle of the Books

At KSDS, we expand literacy opportunities through meaningful community partnerships. Student teams read ten prescribed books throughout the school year in preparation for the spring Battle of the Books competition, where they demonstrate their deep understanding of the stories alongside other county schools. In 2024–25, both our elementary and middle school teams earned first place. This remarkable achievement in a nationally recognized competition was made possible by the dedication of parent volunteer coaches and the guidance of our KSDS library.



Book Shuk

Book Shuk began as a way to keep students engaged in reading during the summer months, ensuring they maintain progress and build their “reading muscle” as lifelong learners. In partnership with Charm City Books, KSDS curated grade-level reading lists for lower school students and provided all required summer reading for middle school students. Families participated both for convenience and for pleasure, creating a schoolwide culture of summer reading. The program’s success has set the stage for it to become an annual tradition.



Author in Residence

The Silverman-Brown Author in Residence program, generously supported by the Silverman-Brown family, is a treasured opportunity for K–8 students. In 2024–25, KSDS welcomed Baltimore author Kathy MacMillian, who shared her expertise as a published writer and ASL interpreter. Her work connected directly to our literacy and global studies curriculum, and she inspired students not only with her books but also with lessons on communication and empathy.

A highlight of the year is always meeting established authors who share their journeys and bring beloved books to life. In addition to the Silverman-Brown Author in Residence program with Kathy MacMillian, KSDS students met several distinguished guests:



Eve Vogelstein presented *Prince Charming in the Garden of Eve* and *Kids in the Kingdom* to our youngest learners, in partnership with the Goldsmith Early Childhood Center art teacher. Lessons focused on ecology, rare frog species, and were taught outdoors in our community garden.

Jen Calonita met with fourth and fifth graders to share her newest adventure novel, *The Isle of Ever*, sparking lively discussion about characters, storytelling, and the publishing process.



Erin Entrada Kelly, two-time Newbery Award winner, visited eighth graders to discuss her biography *At Last She Stood*, about Josefina “Joey” Guerrero. She offered insights into the research process and left students inspired by this remarkable historical figure.

Alan Gatz, #1 New York Times bestselling author, connected virtually with grades five through seven to discuss *Ban This Book*, *Refugee*, and *Two Degrees*. Students gained a deeper understanding of his writing and research process while asking thoughtful questions about the books they studied in class.

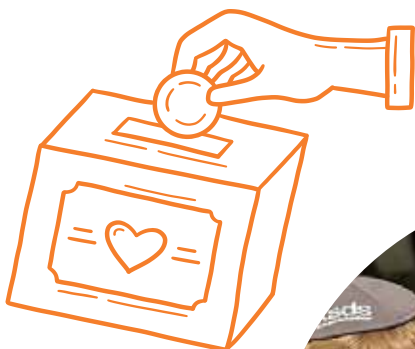
